

Year 2 Elective Modules

HS4105 Cross Cultural Psychology (30 hours)

This elective module aims to equip students with an understanding of culture and the many ways it affects human behaviour. It aims to give students the skills to experience the world around us from the perspective of people from various cultures.

HS4202 Health Informatics (30 hours)

This elective module provides an overview of health informatics which involves understanding and promoting the effective organization, analysis, management and use of information and computer technology in health care. It also aims to discuss the positive role of information technology in the delivery of health care services.

HS4203 Entrepreneurship in Health Care (30 hours)

The aim of this elective module is to prepare health science students with basic knowledge and skills to practice entrepreneurial health care management on graduation.

HS4204 Leadership Studies (30 hours)

This elective module aims to enable the students to become knowledgeable in leadership theories and practices and explore ethical and philosophical issues of leadership. Students will also become more aware of practical skills in leadership and how they can contribute to greater effectiveness either as a leader or team member.

HS4205 Physical Fitness for Life (30 hours)

This elective module aims to provide a fundamental framework for the individual to prescribe a scientific training program to improve his/her physical fitness.

HS4206 Introduction to Clinical Trials (30 hours)

The aim of this elective module is to equip students with a basic working knowledge of clinical trials and research.

HS4207 – Health Information Management (30 hours)

This elective module provides participants with the basic concepts of health information management that are important to the delivery of health care. It also aims to discuss the positive role of information management in the delivery of health care services.
