## Selection Criteria

NYP will assess applicants through a range of criteria, including:

- Clear evidence of interest and aptitude for applied learning in polytechnic courses
- Demonstrated interest, talent and aptitude related to the course applied for, through portfolio of works, work attachments or sustained involvement in course-relevant projects
- Awards, achievements, testimonials and recommendations
- Participation in competitions, seminars and relevant CCAs
- Leadership positions or roles in school and/or CCAs

Shortlisted candidates may be required to attend an aptitude test or interview.

### Conditions:

If you receive a conditional offer via the EAE, in order to confirm your place in the polytechnic course, you will still have to sit for your GCE O Levels and meet the following admission criteria:

1. Obtain a net ELR2B2 score of not more than 26 points for the Singapore-Cambridge GCE O-Level examinations; and
2. Meet the Minimum Entry Requirements (MERs) for the respective polytechnic courses that they have been offered under the EAE.
