

Certificate in Bridging Studies for Enrolled Nurse (NITEC in Nursing)

This Certificate in Bridging Studies for Enrolled Nurse (NITEC in Nursing) aims to provide an opportunity for selected Enrolled Nurses without the relevant general educational qualification, to obtain higher level knowledge to enable them to be admitted to the Diploma in Nursing and cope with the rigours of the course.

Synopsis of Modules

Academic Writing and Presentation Skills (45 Hrs)

This module enables students to acquire language proficiency and the skills necessary for the preparation, presentation and writing of academic papers as part of the course requirement in a Diploma programme.

Basic Sciences (45 hrs)

This module examines basic concepts in chemistry and physics at a level appropriate to the needs of students applying to the Diploma in Nursing programme.

Mathematics (45 hrs)

This module aims to provide students with the concepts of mathematics and its application to nursing practice.

Duration

16 weeks on a part-time basis, offered on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 0900-1200hrs.

Course Fee

The total course fees including 7%GST is \$1150.

Organisations may apply for Skills Redevelopment Programme (SRP) funding.

Entry Requirements

To be eligible for the course, applicants must:

- 1) Have the NITEC in Nursing Certificate with a GPA of 2.8 to <3.0 with passes at first attempt
- 2) Have a minimum of two years post-enrolment working experience;

Preference would be given to those recommended by the employer.

Application

Details of the course will be announced as and when the course is offered. The course will be conducted based on sufficient number of applicants.
