Mental and Physical Disabilities	<p>Due to the special requirements of the healthcare professions, all candidates have to pass a medical examination and be certified to have the following abilities to perform patient care activities in a safe and effective manner. Those who are unable to complete or fulfil the requirements of the pre-enrolment medical examination will be deemed as unfit to pursue the course of study.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mental ability (interpersonal ability and behavioral stability) to provide safe care to populations, as well as safety to self, and demonstrate self-control and behavioral stability to function and adapt effectively and sensitively in a dynamic role. • Physical ability to move around in clinical environment, walk/stand, bend, reach, lift, climb, push and pull, carry objects and perform complex sequences of hand eye coordination. • Auditory ability to hear faint body sounds, auditory alarms and normal speaking level sounds (i.e. blood pressure sounds, monitors, call bells and person-to-person report). • Visual ability to detect changes in physical appearance, colour and contour, read medication labels, syringes, manometers, and written communication accurately. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • [C72] Oral Health Therapy • [C97] Nursing
