

**Nanyang Polytechnic (NYP)**  
**Admission for Academic Year 2025 Intake**  
**Entrance Test Information**

- 1) The Entrance Test, to be conducted online, is jointly organised by the five Polytechnics in Singapore. Shortlisted candidates are required to choose **only one Polytechnic to take the Entrance Test**. The same test paper for each subject will be used across all the Polytechnics, held on the same day, at the same time.
- 2) NYP courses are categorized into **4 aggregate types**:

Please refer to [Annex A](#) to check the **aggregate type** of your DAE course choices to determine which test papers you are required to sit for.

\*Candidates may be exempted from sitting for the English Paper if they have achieved any of the following English Language proficiency minimum scores. **Please include this document in your DAE application** for verification if you wish to be exempted from the English Paper:

- IELTS / IELTS Indicator / IELTS One Skill Retake with minimum overall score of 6.0, with minimum score of 6.0 for all individual assessment components of Listening, Reading, Writing and Speaking
- TOEFL (iBT) / TOEFL iBT® Special Home Edition with minimum score of 78
- Year 12 English Language subject with minimum score of 70% from any of these native English-speaking countries: USA, Canada, Australia & New Zealand

#Candidates are to choose one out of six available Science subjects for the Entrance Test:

- Biology
- Chemistry
- Physics
- Combined Science (Physics & Chemistry)
- Combined Science (Physics & Biology)
- Combined Science (Chemistry & Biology)

Please note that the science subject offerings may be subjected to change which will be confirmed by early Nov 2024.

- 3) Candidates shortlisted for Entrance Test will receive an email invitation from NYP by **2<sup>nd</sup> Dec 2024**. The email will provide further instructions on how to submit the choice of Polytechnic for your Entrance Test. Please complete your submission by **6<sup>th</sup> Dec 2024** (Only one submission is required and in the event you submit multiple times, the latest submission will be taken as final).

- 4) Shortlisted candidates are required to make a fee payment of SGD\$40.00 (subject to the prevailing GST) for each subject paper. The fees are to be paid to the Polytechnic that you have chosen to take the Entrance Test.

If you have chosen to take Entrance Test with Nanyang Polytechnic, you will receive instructions to make payment via **PayNow/Bank Transfer/Telegraphic Transfer** at a later date. Candidates are to keep a copy of the payment transaction as proof upon request. We regret that fees paid are non-refundable.

- 5) The syllabus for all the subjects to be tested and sample test papers are available at our [website](#).
- 6) All subject papers, to be taken **online**, will be scheduled within the same day, on **22<sup>nd</sup> Jan 2025**. The duration of each subject paper is **90 minutes**. Sufficient breaks will be given between papers. More details will be shared by the respective Polytechnic you will be taking the Entrance Test with at a later date. Do note that your Entrance Test results will be shared among the Polytechnics to facilitate processing of your DAE applications.
- 7) A mock test will be conducted one to two weeks before the actual Entrance Test to help candidates get familiar with the Entrance Test process. It is therefore compulsory for all candidates to attend before the actual Entrance Test.
- 8) Please note that meeting the Minimum Entry Requirements (MER) is not a guarantee that an applicant will be shortlisted. An invitation to sit for entrance test does not guarantee admission to the course.
