Dear Student,

The Ministry of Education's Tuition Grant (TG) Scheme is to help defray the cost of full-time diploma courses at polytechnics for students.

As a SPR, you are eligible to apply for a TG upon successful enrolment into a polytechnic, provided you have not received TG previously to complete a course at the same or higher level of education.

To confirm eligibility, students must submit the Tuition Grant Option form by the enrolment deadline, which can be accessed through the provided QR code or URL below:

If your application is successful, the grant will be applied directly on the total amount due on your Student Bill at Nanyang Polytechnic. You will be required to seek and secure employment with a Singapore entity to serve the three-year bond upon graduation.

If your application is unsuccessful, or should you decide not to apply for TG, you will need to pay the full tuition fees for your studies at Nanyang Polytechnic.
